Additional opportunity for the COVID-19 vaccine for children aged 12 to 15

Dear Parent / Carer,

As you may be aware, a session recently took place in your child's school offering the COVID-19 vaccination to all children aged between 12-15. This is in line with the government offer from 13th September and following advice from the UK's chief medical officers that all children are offered one dose of the Pfizer-BioNtech COVID-19 vaccination.

Not all children received the vaccine at these sessions, reasons include:

- Consent form distributed by your child's school was not completed and returned to school on the day
- Your child declined to have the vaccine.
- Your child did not attend their appointment
- Your child recently had COVID-19 or was displaying symptoms.
- Your child was not between the ages of 12-15 on the day of vaccination.
- The vaccination session was re-scheduled.

I am pleased to inform you that additional opportunities are now available now available for your child to receive the covid vaccine.
